# BREDFIELD AND DISTRICT COMMUNITY COUNCIL

The Community Council was set up in 1975 to provide amenities for the residents of the four parishes of Bredfield, Boulge, Dallinghoo and Debach, and currently has about 200 members. Affiliated to the Community Council for Suffolk (Suffolk-ACRE), its activities include arranging social activities, fund raising for community projects (notably the new Bredfield Village Hall), support for facilities under threat in or area and initial support for new ventures. The Executive Committee includes representatives of each local organisation that wishes to be affiliated.

The Community Council produces a monthly newsletter, containing news about the activities of all the local clubs and organisations (catering for quite a range of interests), forthcoming events, personal items of news, and items of community interest. In 1989 the Community Council set up a village shop adjacent to Bredfield Village Hall. With the active help of a large number of volunteer helpers drawn from the community, this aims to provide a service for the local community by stocking a wide variety of goods. As it is a non profit-making venture, prices are very competitive.

Membership of the Community Council is open to all residents of the four parishes, and new members are always welcome. The current membership fee is £3.60 p.a. (£2.40 for senior citizens), of which 40% is allocated to a monthly draw, and the remainder used to provide or improve local amenities. The subscription may be paid quarterly, half-yearly or annually, whichever is most convenient. A team of collectors helps to collect subscriptions and deliver the Newsletter to all parts of the BDCC area.
